I am excited to announce that Anja Woolverton, school parent, will be our new preschool assistant teacher. Anja will be the assistant for all three preschool sessions.

I'm also happy to announce that After School Care hours have been extended to 6:00 pm. Care is offered before school (7:00-8:15 am) and after school for Kindergartener-8th graders. The charge is \$5 per morning per child and \$8 per afternoon per child. Extended care is not available to preschoolers

I need all parents to check our school website, www.saint-johns.net/school, for forms that need to be completed to finalize enrollment. The completed forms need to be returned on Back to School Open House on August 15.

All families need to complete the enrollment process by attending Back to School Open House, August 15, any time from 9am-11am in the gym. The Open House provides you and your child an opportunity to sign up for the school lunch program, before/after school care, return important forms, pick up school supply orders, and purchase new uniform items. This is a great opportunity for students to see their classrooms and meet their new teachers. Monday, August 18 is the first full day of school. School hours for K-8th grades are 8:15am-3:30pm.

## ☐ Permission for Medication Form: (as needed)

Students needing prescription or over the counter drugs (e.g. cough drops) administered at school must have a Permission for Medication Form" accompanying medication. Medication cannot be administered at school without



authorization. Forms are available on the school website and in the school office, when needed.

	<b>Asthma Consent form:</b> Preschoolers-8th graders may self-administer medication for the treatment of asthma and naphylaxis while at school. A completed "Asthma Consent Form" must accompany the medication. Forms are vailable on the school website and in the school office, as needed.				
	<b>Free or Reduced Lunch Program:</b> This program is funded by the government, which provides financial relief for those in need. A copy of the application is available on the school website, the school office, and will be available the Back to School Open House. Complete the application and return to Mrs. Alexander.
