## **Dear Parents**,

A parent recently asked me how we determine St. John School tuition and cost of education of \$4,800. It is hard for me to think of putting a price tag on the education and environment at St. John School, but bills and salaries need to be paid so an important part of my job is to oversee the finances of the school.

Our 2014-15 school budget is \$1,423,464. We currently have 281 kindergarten through eighth graders. If you do the math, the cost per kindergarten-8th grade student is \$5,066. That figure does not include preschool students who pay a monthly fee, the many fund raisers we hold, the yearly fees we collect, and it does not factor in St. John Parish financial support to the school.

It costs a great deal of money to run a school and we all share the financial responsibility to provide the academic and spiritual education that St. John School provides.
