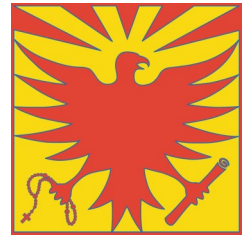

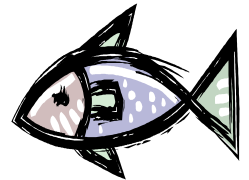


Lenten Fish Fry

Knights of Columbus presents the Lenten Fish Fry every Friday night during Lent 5:00-7:00 pm in the church basement.

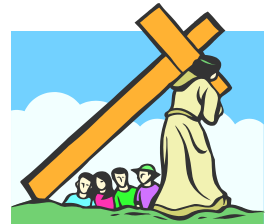
