

# **SOCIAL JUSTICE SOCIAL ACTION**

St. John has been a support congregation for Family Promise of Lawrence since the inception of Family Promise. We provide support to Corpus Christi when they house Family Promise quests.

Since Covid-19, Family Promise is providing services to not only their guests, but also guest families from Willow Domestic Violence Center and the Lawrence Community Shelter. Transitional housing has been arranged for all these families. Congregations are not providing housing and meals at churches at this time.

We received the following information from Family Promise recently:

As you are aware, our normal rotation model of sheltering families has changed due to COVID-19. We are currently sheltering several families in-place, outside of the congregational setting, and we anticipate this will continue for the foreseeable future.

Family Promise still needs your help. We are asking that the host church and supporting congregation/organization continue to provide food for the families during their hosting week, but in a slightly different way:

We ask that congregations/organizations provide groceries for the week for each family, rather than prepared meals. Grocery lists are provided as guidance.

The Family Promise Roster email will still go out on Wednesday each week to the host church and support congregation/ organization and those hosting the two following weeks. This will contain the number of families, names of family members and ages of those who are in shelter and will receive the groceries.

John Booth is coordinating food delivery. He will contact coordinators several weeks prior to your hosting week, and will introduce you to Kathy McCurley, who organizes the actual food drop off. Meals certainly look different right now, but the need is present. We appreciate your recognition of this need and your support of the families Thank you for the continuation of hospitality



shown through your service. Please recognize that we are hard at work as an organization to minimize the impact that COVID-19 has on guests and volunteers. Our hope is that you all stay safe and healthy. We appreciate your willingness to help these families in all the unique ways presented during this time. Stay well and God bless each of you for your commitment to people and this community. Thank you!"







# FOCUS ON THE WORD

# UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

ou can feel so small standing by the seashore. The vastness of all that is before you expands much farther than your eye can see. What is happening on the other side? As tides continue to ebb and flow, what occurs as they come and go remains largely a mystery and the effects of their presence unknown in your sight. Yet, things are moving and changing as you gaze upon the water, as the thumbprint of their presence is left behind. The greater the wind and wave, the greater the effect. But even a gentle breeze leaves its humble mark upon the seashore on which you stand. The smallest pebble still makes a ripple in the great blue expanse of ocean waters. It doesn't need to be big.

You never know the full impact of your smallest gesture or simplest of words. A yes or no, agree or disagree, here or there, this or that can influence time and history in ways you may never know. The Holy Spirit is like that: fierce and torrential, and then almost still and silent, creating and recreating none-

theless. Coming as a gentle breeze or a gusty wind, God's Holy Spirit continues to move over, around, and into the waters of our lives. The Spirit brings fruit and unknown possibilities to what we humbly bring with us and that same Spirit eventually brings all to fulfillment in Christ.

The first disciples didn't have much. They possessed simple faith and a willingness to go into unchartered territory with a love of their friend-God, humble offerings, and a knowledge that they were not alone. This allowed them to do amazing things with very little. Do you believe that you are being led and that you have a purposeful life? We often do not realize our value because we do not think that the little we have is good enough. How wrong we are! A little flour mixed with water and embraced by a prayer of blessing transforms simple offerings into the magnificent Eucharistic presence of



God. If the Holy Spirit can do such amazing things with these humble gifts of the earth, even more can happen with you. Don't underestimate the value of the smile you gave a stranger, the door held open for an elderly widow, the listening ear offered to one who was lonely, the tolerance given to the wounded soul who is angry, and the loving shoulder you offered as a cradle under the head of someone in pain.
