SOCIAL JUSTICE SOCIAL ACTION

Social Concerns for Peace and Justice Committee,

We must get a handle on our fears.

Fear influences our thinking on many issues such as religious intolerance, immigration and refugee policies, the criminal justice system, access to affordable housing, voting rights and many others.

Fear can lead to being less tolerant, less trusting, and hyper concerned with "security." Being afraid can cause us to be more suspicious of those who are different and to oppose policies that offer assistance to those on the margins. It can prevent us from speaking truth to power. At the same time, fear makes us vulnerable to individuals and organizations that take advantage of people who are afraid.

Some of the top issues Americans worry about are: Not having enough money for the future **55%** Global warming and climate change **57%** Extinction of plant and animal species **59%** Air pollution **59%** Pollution of drinking water **64%** Pollution of oceans, rivers and lakes **68%** -Chapman University Survey of American Fears

75% of Americans are concerned that they, or someone close to them, could lose their housing. -The NHP Foundation

64% of Americans believe that there is more crime in the U.S. -despite the fact that violent crimes dropped from **80** per **1,000** Americans in 1993 to just **23** in 2018. -Gallup

Americans estimate their chances of being robbed in the coming year at **15%**, even though the actual rate is closer to **1%**.

Demand for firearms has spiked after elections and mass shootings such as the Sandy Hook massacre in 2012. 2020 saw a jump to nearly **40 million** background checks from the previous record around **28 million** in 2019 amid the pandemic, racial unrest, election-related violence and the fear of stricter gun regulation.

Yet, the phrase "Fear not" or "Be not afraid," appears more than **300** times in Scripture.

Let us pray that we be given the strength to cultivate courage, and that we trust and engage more and fear less.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO

Cuantas veces, en medio de las tormentas de la vida, nos hemos preguntado: ¿Dónde está Dios? ¿Acaso está dormido? ¿Por qué no acude a nuestro auxilio? Sin embargo, Dios está ahí entre nosotros, en medio de la tormenta, en medio de la pandemia. ¿Dónde estás Jesús que no te veo, que no te siento? Le preguntamos, muchas veces desesperados y ya sin aliento. ¡Escúchanos Señor, no nos abandones! Para comprender cómo actúa Dios, debemos meditar y reflexionar en su Palabra. Escuchemos lo que narra el Evangelio de hoy.

"Al atardecer de aquel mismo día, Jesús dijo a sus discípulos: 'Crucemos a la otra orilla del lago'. Despidieron a la gente y lo llevaron en la barca en que estaba... de pronto, se levantó un gran temporal y las olas se estrellaban contra la barca, que se iba llenando de agua. Mientras tanto Jesús dormía en la popa sobre un cojín. Lo despertaron diciendo: Maestro, ¿no te importa que nos hundamos? Él entonces se despertó. Se encaró con el viento y dijo al mar: 'Cállate, cálmate'. El viento se apaciguo y siguió una gran calma. Después dijo: '¿Por qué son tan miedosos? ¿Todavía no tienen fe?" (Marcos 4:35-40). El miedo paraliza, el miedo hunde y destruye muchos planes y buenas acciones. En el caso de los discípulos, el miedo pudo haberse superado con confianza en la presencia de Jesús, aunque estuviera durmiendo. Ahora bien, en los casos actuales cabe la pregunta. ¿Cómo supero las dificultades? ¿Vence el miedo o la confianza y fe en Dios? 



SAFE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAM - ADULT TRAINING (VIRTUS)
