# SOCIAL JUSTICE SOCIAL ACTION

*By The Social Concerns for Peace and Justice Committee*

Again, we are partnering with Catholic Charities and Centro Hispano to help families in our Lawrence community who are living in poverty. Again this year, we hope to provide households with a food voucher so that they can buy food to go with the turkey they will be receiving for Thanksgiving from Catholic Charities.

This is where you come in. If my math is correct, if 400 families in our parish would donate \$10, we could provide 40 families with a \$40 food voucher.

We'd like to invite you to help with this project. You may put a check in the collection basket, designating in the memo that it is for Thanksgiving vouchers. Now here are a few more tips to help you live a more environmentally friendly lifestyle:

### 36. Stainless steel metal straws

Many eateries are replacing plastic disposable straws with usable ones. You can get your own stainless steel set of straws and store them with the rest of your reusable cutlery.

### 37. Repair your things

When stuff breaks try and repair it first before you decide to throw it out to avoid waste. Check if stuff is fixable before rushing to buy new ones.

### 38. Use what you have

Practice living an eco friendly lifestyle by always checking around your home for what you already have that can minimize wastage. For instance, if you need to store food away? If you don't have too much space in your kitchen for a sophisticated bin system, a simple plastic tub in the laundry or somewhere else out of the way will do. 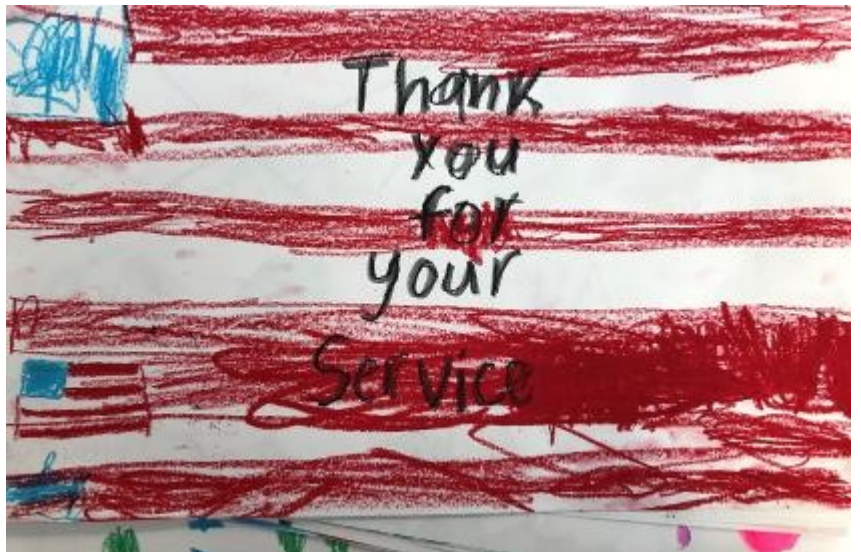

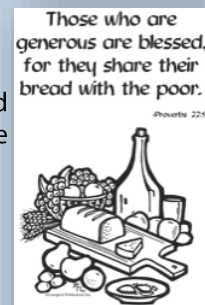

### Long Live the King

Did you know that you can become royalty, for the right price? It's true — for the low, low cost of \$50, you, too, can purchase a 12-square-inch souvenir plot of Scottish land and call yourself "Laird So-and-so." Now, this lordship or ladyship doesn't come with the ability to boss anyone around, but maybe your friends will be impressed enough to bend the knee.

My point is, we've all got our own little fiefdoms — folks or communities for which we have a feeling of responsibility. Maybe we're not their "king," but most of us have those we think of as "our people."

Now, in this world, people lay themselves down for their kings. History is riddled with the bodies of men, young and old — and plenty of women and children, too — who were casualties of
