

VIRTUS. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon**. You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

Go to: https://www.virtusonline.org.

- Click on "First-Time Registrant"
- 2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
- 3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
- 4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
- 5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
- 6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.
- 7. VIRTUS Registration MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.

SOCIAL JUSTICE SOCIAL

We know that in Jesus's day, he often instructed people by using parables, a story form that basically would turn social teachings and norms upside down. He used story to teach to keep from getting killed, as this was a real risk if he would have directly "gotten to the point."

Prayer can follow the same methodology. There have been a couple of "reverse" peace prayers of St. Francis of Assisi that have been floating around lately. The one we like best is written by a Franciscan, Fr. Daniel P. Horan, OFM., a noted book author and a columnist for National Catholic Reporter. You'll find the prayer below. Notice how he modifies each petition in the familiar Prayer for Peace of St. Francis of Assisi by keeping the integrity of the prayer's structure, but by replacing concepts to call us to consider contemporary themes. We pray that this prayer moves you.

PEACE PRAYER FOR THE PRIVILEGED

Lord, make me an instrument of your holy discomfort Where there is privilege, let me sow equity, Where there is violence, let me work for peace, Where there is division, let me seek unity, Where there is racism, let me pursue racial justice, Where there is environmental degradation, let me care for creation.

Where there is political discord, let me seek the common good, And where there is economic inequality, let me seek justice. OGod of Justice, grant that I may not so much seek comfort, as to welcome hard truths,

To be heard, as to listen,

To hold power, as to empower,

To seek control, as to follow,

For it is in humility, that we learn,

It is in seeking forgiveness, that we are reconciled, And it is in dying to self, that we are born to new life.

ST. KATHARINE DREXEL | MARCH 3



With a family like hers, it's no wonder that St. Katharine Drexel (November 26, 1858 – March 3, 1955) grew up to become one of the first American-born saints.

Born in Philadelphia in 1858, her mother passed away when she was only five weeks old. Her father, a renowned banker, remarried a wonderful woman, and together they raised St. Katherine Drexel and her two sisters in a life of privilege. Both financially and spiritually well-endowed, the Drexels were devout Catholics and set an excellent example of true Christian servitude with prayer and care for the poor.

After her father's death, St. Katharine Drexel gave up her inheritance and instead devoted her life to the material and spiritual well-being of black and native Americans. Mother Drexel, as she would become known as, established the Sisters of the Blessed Sacrament for Indians and Colored, and together they opened a boarding school in Santa Fe, the first of 50 missions for Native Americans in 16 states.

At 77, she suffered a heart attack and was forced to retire from active ministry. She spent the next 20 years of her life in quiet yet intense prayer. She died at the age of 96 and was canonized in 2000 by Pope John Paul II. **©LPi**

El happy end es que Jesús perdono a Maggie que, supuestamente, "no tiene perdón de Dios"






