LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

All Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, March 2, and all the Fridays of Lent. Catholics 18 to 59 years of age are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday — a fast consisting of one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating in between. It is also recommended that Catholics find opportunities throughout the Lenten season to complement their fasts with prayer, reception of the sacraments of reconciliation and the Eucharist, and positive works of charity.

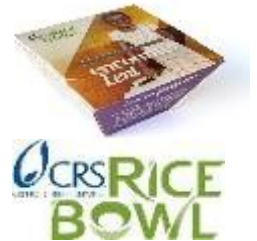

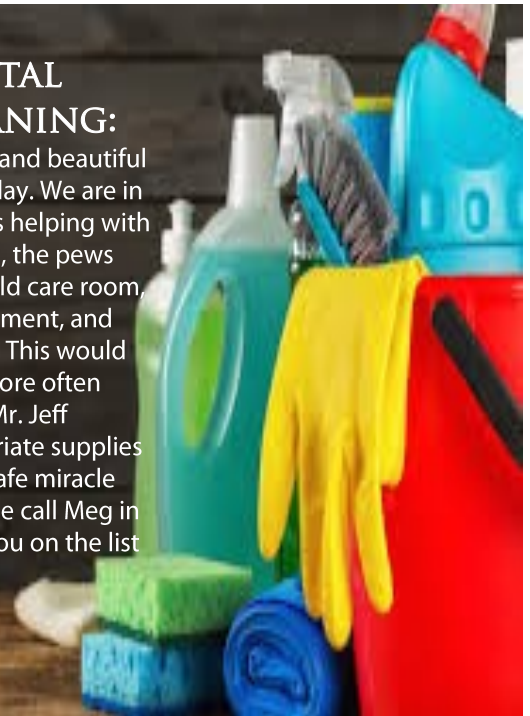
SECOND COLLECTION FOR UKRAINE

VIRTUS, PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon.** You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

Go to: <https://www.virtusonline.org>.

1. Click on "First-Time Registrant"
2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.
7. VIRTUS Registration MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.

SOCIAL JUSTICE SOCIAL ACTION

We recently learned a great acronym which we hope you will find to be useful. For anyone who is working to be more mindful and careful about what they give voice to, this may help.

First, the acronym itself gets your attention. The acronym is: THINK. And this is what it stands for:

T.H.I.N.K. before you speak. Ask yourself each of these questions before responding:

T = Is what you're going to say TRUE?

H = Is it HELPFUL?

I = Is it INSPIRING?

N = Is it NECESSARY? Is it necessary that I say this? Is it necessary that I say this now?

K = Is it KIND?

If you can't answer yes to ALL these questions, don't say anything



This is a way of participating in mindful dialoguing; we take the time to process between what we've heard and what we feel inclined to say originally, and options we may come up with if we find it best not to say what we originally had planned to say.

Jesus and his disciple James both have wisdom for us to consider if we are seeking to rein in an overzealous tongue. If you're looking to do that, good luck, and let us pray for each other!

A STRUGGLING SAINT

The Sanctuary Ministry would like to share with you the story of a saint who struggled with mental health issues.

St Therese of Liseux

Not everyone thinks of St. Therese when it comes to mental health. St. Therese was born in France in 1873. She was the youngest daughter of a mother who desired to be a saint and a father who desired to be a monk. Therese had eight older siblings. Her mother died of cancer when Therese was 4 and ½, and her father died when she was a teenager.

Therese became very ill after her mother's death and there was concern that she might die. Her older sisters would pray in front of a statue of Mary for her and she began to do the same, and Mary smiled and she was healed.

She struggled with a bad temper as a child and the struggle continued into her teens.

She had what was known as a Christmas of conversion which mellowed her tremendously. She was able to stay focused on God instead of herself and what was going on around her.

She joined the convent with her older sisters and she quickly became known as a good, solid nun. She became the formation director for the novices.

In April of 1896, Therese passed away from tuberculosis. Before her death she wrote "Story of a Soul". Her final words were, "Oh, my God, I love you!". St. Therese of Liseux is the patron saint of missions and florists. Her prayer is as follows: O Little Therese of the Child Jesus, please pick for me a rose from the heavenly gardens and send it to me as a message of love. O Little Flower of Jesus, ask God to grant the favors I now place with confidence in your hands . . (mention in silence here) St. Therese, help me to always believe as you did in God's great love for me, so that I might imitate your "Little Way" each day. Amen

¡No me tiren la primera piedra! (Juan 8, 1-11)

En nuestros tiempos, amplios y comprensivos, a una adúltera se la deja tranquila, salvo si el marido se entera y le pide el divorcio. Pero en los viejos tiempos de Jesús, el "machismo" era más brutal, y la pena para una adúltera era morir apedreada (No existía esa pena para el marido adúltero, por lo que, a pesar de que hoy somos más indiferentes frente a este tipo de "problema", la fidelidad y la infidelidad corren para los dos).

Pues bien, aquí tienes, que por un descuido, Sarita, vecina del barrio Ben Gurión, de Jerusalén, creyendo que su esposo: Roberto estaba de viaje de negocios y llegaría recién el martes (tenía muchos clientes que visitar en Betsaida), oyó el lunes a la noche, un grito a la puerta: -¡Sariiiiita, soy yo, ya llegué! ¡Menudo susto el de la mujer, pues estaba en enredos amorosos con su vecino, un tal Kurt, recientemente llegado de Leipzig, vendedor de rulemanes en Sidón!
