

# SCRIPTURAL STATIONS OF THE CROSS


Join us for a very special Scriptural Stations of the Cross

## VALUE THEM BOTH AMENDMENT MEETING

Come learn about the Value Them Both Amendment on **April 2, at 8:30am in the church basement**, presented will be made by Father Bernie Gorges. Kansans can help protect women and babies in our state by learning about the Value Them Both Amendment, which we will vote on in the August 2 primary election.

The amendment:

- Protects existing Kansas law that keeps babies from being aborted up to the moment of birth
- Prevents taxpayer-funded abortion and extreme procedures such as partial-birth and live-dismemberment abortions
- Preserves safeguards that require the abortion industry to protect women with important clinic safety standards

## VIRTUS. PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon**. You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

Go to: https://www.virtusonline.org.

- Click on "First-Time Registrant"
- 2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
- 3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
- 4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
- 5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
- 6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.
- 7. VIRTUS Registration MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.

# **SOCIAL JUSTICE SOCIAL ACTION**

By The Social Concerns for Peace and Justice Committee

This weekend and next, you have a historic opportunity. Pope Francis wants to hear from everyone in the Church, no matter what your relationship or state of harmony or disharmony with the Church happens to be. He wants to hear from those who have left the Catholic Church. He wants to hear from those of other denominations and faiths; he wants to know how those outside the Catholic Church view the Church. He even wants to hear from those with no religious faith.

The word "synodality" comes from roots meaning journeying together. Three primary themes of this inquiry are communion, participation and mission. Any feedback you may have could fit into one or more of those categories.

This week and next, our parish will host listening sessions relevant to this Synod, to which we are all invited and welcomed.

In parish communications including the bulletin, e-blast website and social media outlets, details concerning times and dates of listening sessions and the questions we're using will be posted. Also, these communications will have information about a GoogleDoc form and a PDF form that you may use to submit your input if none of the group times work for you. We have in-person groups and Zoom groups as well.

Never before in the history of our Church has there been such a broad sweep to collect input. There have been synods and similar groups before, but they have not been as inclusive or far-reaching.


Pope Francis wants to help us become a Church that knows what it is to journey together; to listen to each other and to trust each other. Though these things take time, we can pray with hope to the Holy Spirit to guide everyone participating in this process, which is in itself a form of evangelization, in whatever way as we move toward becoming a Church of ongoing, prayerful, discerning and open dialogue and growth together.

Oh, and yes, this is doing justice, of the most holy kind; visiting prayerful and discerned dialogue upon your Church! And it's Scriptural: Jesus and his disciples had spirited dialogues about Jewish law and tradition regularly. That's how their relationships grew into such loving and loyal relationships. Like Jesus and his disciples, we must care for our relationship with our Church so that it can be nurtured and can grow stronger and deeper.

# ST. OSCAR ROMERO | MARCH 24

When St. Oscar Romero was appointed Archbishop of San Salvador in 1977, his country was in chaos. Many people in El Salvador were living in poverty, while a smaller elite group controlled all political and economic power. In 1980, El Salvador broke out in a 12-year civil war that left over 75,000 people dead. St. Oscar Romero set up pastoral programs to assist the victims of oppression. He also became an outspoken advocate for human rights, appealing to the Salvadoran military to stop killing their own citizens.

On March 24, 1980, St. Oscar Romero was murdered while celebrating Mass in El Salvador. A car pulled up outside, and a gunman fired a single shot straight into St. Oscar Romero's heart.

Calling him a "a martyr for the faith" nearly 40 years later, Pope Francis canonized him in 2018. For the occasion, Pope Francis chose to wear the same blood-stained belt that Romero was wearing at the altar when he died.

#### **CUENTO NÚMERO 27**

#### ¿Quién lo hubiera dicho? ¡Dios es mi papá! (Lucas 11. 1-4)

Hace poco, en un día fresco y soleado, me tire debajo de un árbol y deje que mi cabeza "volara" y que los pensamientos surgieran y me llevaran a cualquier parte. Y mi mente recaló en el Padrenuestro, la oración que Jesús nos enseñó para que nos definiéramos como hijos y como hermanos. No tenía ganas de elaborar "ideas", sino de transitar por los sentimientos que algunas ideas provocan. Comencé casi a deletrear la oración: Padre...

Sin pronunciar más, me di cuenta de que sólo un hijo puede llamar a alguien "padre". A mi tío lo llamo "tío", y no padre. A mis primos los llamo "primos" (o Pepe y "el Cholo"), pero no padre. Por eso me supe y me sentí "hijo", al ser capaz de pronunciar la palabra "padre".

Pero leyendo otro párrafo de los evangelios y con las explicaciones de un amigo que conoce bien el hebreo, constaté que Jesús llama a Dios Abba, que significa papá, más aún, papito. Entonces caí en la cuenta de que no sólo era un hijo, sino más bien un hijito, un hijo menor y muy chico: un niño...

Cuando somos muy pequeños, "mi papá" es lo más grande que hay. Todo lo puede y, porque es "mi papá", puede más que el papá de otro y que todos los papás del mundo que no son "mi papá".

Pero en ese hermoso día, fresco y luminoso, el sol calentó mis sentimientos, y pude llamar a Dios, no una sino mil veces: - "papito...", "papi...", "pa...". A veces, suele ocurrir - de modo especial en los niños pequeños, pero no sólo en ellos - que se ponen "mimosos" y van a los brazos del papá buscando la seguridad que ellos ofrecen, buscando ser regaloneados y acariciados. Eso me paso, hace no mucho tiempo.

Y "el cuentito" no es "cuento". Podemos y debemos dejar de lado las excesivas solemnidades que sólo merecerían los dioses almidonados, "enfermos de jerarquía", en pedestales tan pero tan altos, que ninguna mirada de hombre puede alcanzarlos, verlos, oírlos, tocarlos, sentirlos, ¡amarlos! ¡Y Dio es amor! Y para amar a alguien hay que saberlo y sentirlo cercano, de modo que pueda conocer y sentir su amor, amor que se expresará de mil modos, porque si yo puedo llamar a Dios "papito", él puede llamarme a mi "hijito". Y "los hijitos" quieren jugar con su "papito". Y "el papito" arma el trencito eléctrico y juga con sus hijitos, tirado sobre el piso con ellos, gritando, entusiasmado....

¿No tendríamos que desarmar nuestra religión de tantos superlativos que, si bien marcan la trascendencia absoluta de Dios (que no negamos ni olvidamos...), se olvidan de que ese Dios lejano decidió, porque no puede con su genio de enamorado, que había que llamarlo "papito", en vez de "Fuerza Superior" o "Primer Motor Inmóvil" o "Causa Suprema de todo lo que es"? Este "dios" no es capaz de caricia ni de ternura. No juega con sus hijos, simplemente porque ese dios no tiene hijos. No me recibe cuando tiendo mis brazos a lo alto buscando a mi papá. No da la vida por nadie, porque a nadie conoce.


