## LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

All Catholics 14 years of age and older are obliged to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, March 2, and all the Fridays of Lent. Catholics 18 to 59 years of age are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday — a fast consisting of one normal meal and two lesser meals, with no eating in between. It is also recommended that Catholics find opportunities throughout the Lenten season to complement their fasts with prayer, reception of the sacraments of reconciliation and the Eucharist, and positive works of charity.

## VIRTUS, PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon.** You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

Go to: <https://www.virtusonline.org>.

1. Click on "First-Time Registrant"
2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.
7. VIRTUS Registration MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.

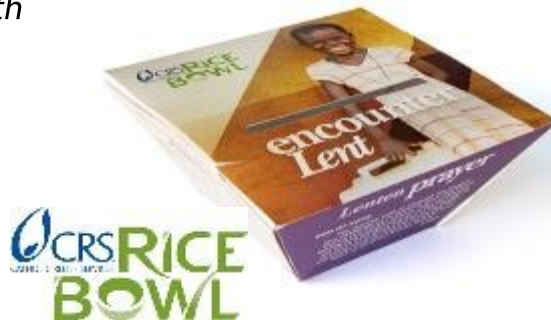

## CUENTO NÚMERO 25

### Zaqueo: un petiso sinvergüenza que se convirtió en un petiso bueno (Lucas 19, 1-10)

¿Se puede contar esta historia mejor que como está ya narrada? Me parece que no, pero si no lo intento, el cuentito no saldrá, me con venceré de que todo lo hecho no sirve para nada porque está muy pero muy bien dicho por los evangelistas, tiraré todo al canasto de la basura y después me arrepentiré por haber perdido tan tontamente el tiempo. Por eso me largo, enchufo mi computer y... ¡que salga lo que Dios quiera y lo que yo pueda!

Una vez conocí a un tipo llamado Diego: Diego Ignacio, para ser más exacto. Era bastante pícaro, un modo suave de decir que era mujeriego, jugador que despilfarraba el dinero y que se mostraba insensible con los pobres y los afligidos, "criaturas molestas", como los llamaba. Decía que "vida había una sola" y que había que gozarla. Con frecuencia me he topado con mucho Diegosignacios como éste.

No sé de dónde sacaba el dinero, porque lo tenía en sobreabundancia y, en todo tiempo y lugar, ha sido difícil tener "demasiado" por medios lícitos. Estaba relacionado con las altas esferas del gobierno y siempre tenía "reuniones de trabajo" con ejecutivos y funcionarios de importancia. Creo, sin temor a equivocarme, que estaba metido hasta la médula de los huesos en negociados no santos...

Nos enteramos de que un ministro convocó a una licitación privada lo que tenía que ser hecho por licitación pública y, ¡oh casualidad!, una de las empresas de Diego Ignacio ganó, del modo más transparente, la licitación. Y así siguieron las cosas...

Lo vi e intenté cruzarme a la vereda de enfrente, pero era tarde: él me vio y se acercó a saludarme. Para mis adentros, pensé: -Éste no sabe quién soy y me ha confundido con otro. Que se sentía, día a día, más sensible y solidario con los necesitados.

Callé. Hice un hondo silencio, como quien construye un edificio grande. Mi orgullo me impidió pedirle perdón, pero en verdad me alegré de que la salvación
