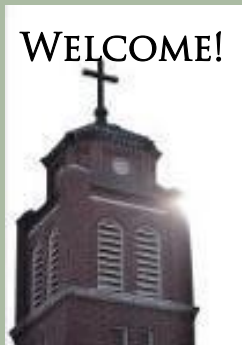

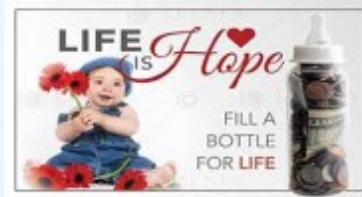

ALLEGATION AGAINST CAPUCHIN FRANCISCAN, FR. MIKE SCULLY FOUND UNSUBSTANTIATED

Denver, CO, May 4, 2022: On February 25, 2022, the Capuchin Province of Mid-America (St. Conrad), of which Fr. Michael Scully is a member, was notified of an allegation of sexual misconduct against Fr. Scully. After a thorough investigation of the allegation by an independent investigator and review by the Province's Independent Review Board the allegation was found to be "unsubstantiated," which means the allegation was not credible based on investigative findings. As a result, Fr. Scully is cleared of this allegation.

The Province treats any allegation with great respect and concern. Upon notice of the allegation, the Province

immediately notified law enforcement of the accusation and commenced a thorough investigation and review in accordance with the Province's standard procedures. Additionally, while Fr. Scully strongly denied the accusation, he was immediately suspended from all ministry pending findings of this investigation.

When an allegation of sexual abuse is brought to our attention, we recognize the pain experienced by the victims and their families, the accused, the entire Church community, and our own community of brothers. We continue to hold in our prayers all those involved in this case.

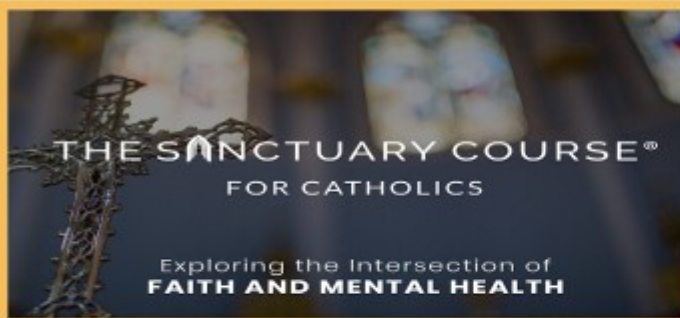
SECOND COLLECTION MAY 29

VIRTUS, PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN FOR ADULTS

All employees of the Archdiocese (including clergy and consecrated laymen and laywomen) and all volunteers (including Vacation Bible School volunteers), over the age of 18, who have substantial contact with children and/or youth, in the school or church, are required to submit a background check and attend VIRTUS, the awareness session of the Archdiocese's child abuse program, Protecting God's Children for Adults, prior to working with children or youth.

All VIRTUS sessions are online, **however, this will be changing soon.** You will need to register an account with our Archdiocese and complete the background check and paperwork.

Go to: <https://www.virtusonline.org>.

1. Click on "First-Time Registrant"
2. Click on "Begin the registration process."
3. On the "Select" organization drop-down menu, select "Kansas City in Kansas (Archdiocese)".
4. Create a User ID and Password, complete the profile information, and select a class to attend.
5. You must complete the background check and paperwork at this point.
6. Plan to have 20-30 minutes to register and complete the online paperwork. The system will not allow you to save what you start working on and return at a later time to complete. **DO NOT USE THE BACK BUTTON ON THE ADDRESS BAR, OR IT WILL DELETE YOUR PROGRESS AND YOU WILL HAVE TO START OVER.**
7. VIRTUS Registration **MUST BE DONE ON A COMPUTER**, not a tablet, iPad or phone. The system will not allow these devices due to security reasons.

Así como hay árboles flojos, de raíces poco profundas, existen edificios cuyos basamentos no dan fe acerca de su estabilidad. De esto trata nuestro cuentito.

Había una vez un gallego amigo que se dijo: -Yo no gasto plata en arquitectos. ¡No saben nada! Tengo un amigo "maestro mayor de obras", y eso vale más que todos los títulos. Además, cuida los bolsillos del cliente, y no como esos arquitectos que se quieren lucir gastando en cosas superfluas. ¿Qué hay que aprobar los planos? ¡Pamplinas! Si es sólo "una ampliación" lo que quiero hacer yo. ¡No me vengan con historias...!

Y el "maestro mayor de obras" comenzó su sesuda tarea. Lo primero que hizo fue ir a donde vendían escombros, total... - Para los cimientos no hay por qué poner cemento "nuevo", cuando los escombros bien molidos cumplen perfectamente esa función. 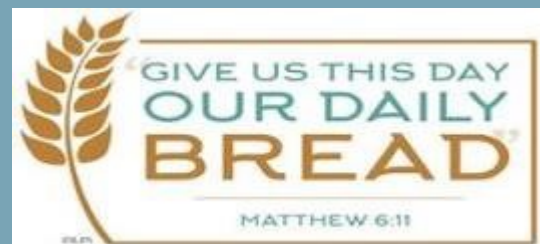
