Educational Logs

We are going to make a change with the educational logs. Students in K-5 that check in with their teacher in the morning and afternoon will no longer need to do an educational log for the day. If you are unable to check in during a morning session or afternoon session please fill out a log for the half of the day that you had missed. Or if you are not able to check in with a teacher but are completing your work for the day please fill out a log for the day. This will be how we will handle educational logs Monday- Thursday. Because we have a different schedule for Friday, students will still need to do an educational log. For middle school students, if you miss a class, please fill out an educational log for any class you miss that day but are still able to complete work for. I hope everyone is ok with this change.

I know parents have been asking about Friday. Friday is meant to be a day to catch up with students. Teachers will have office hours for students or parents to ask questions and check in about assignments. It is also a day to catch up on assignments if students are working more in the evening time. We know from last week that Monday - Thursday can be pretty busy so we want to make sure students have time to catch up and don't feel too overwhelmed.

If your child is sick or you know they are going to be absent, we do ask that you call into the office to let us know just like any other school day.

Starting this week, students will be able to put books on reserve to be checked out of our library. Homeroom teachers will be sending out login information early this week. Students will need to login to our new system to be able to put books on reserve. Please place books on reserve by Thursday evening and they will be ready to pick up next Tuesday between 3:30-5:30 in the school parking lot.
