### **Academic Improvements for St. John**

I wanted to take some time to share some of the academic changes we as a staff have made since our Accreditation review in January. We have worked very hard to make solid improvements and practices that we feel will make a long-term impact on the quality of St. John.

**Eagle Time** - We have scheduled specific time 4 days a week for all staff to work with students helping to create opportunities for reteaching, reinforcing, and providing enrichment in reading and math skills to help support the learning needs of our diverse student population.

**Fastbridge** - Fatsbridge is a new assessment tool that we will use for Kindergarten - 8th grade. We will do this 3 times a year to help us support the growth of our students. The data from Fastbridge will help us to make adjustments to instruction in the classroom and during Eagle Time. This will also allow us to do ongoing assessments with students that need extra support.

**Lexia in Grade 4th-8th Grade** - Adopted in the spring of 2021, Lexia is our new computer-based reading skills program that identifies individual learner needs. Teachers are monitoring data daily to identify individuals or small groups whose data indicates additional instruction is needed for skill acquisition. Through the Lexia Resource Center, teachers are provided quality lesson plans that help to target the instruction of specific skills for individual learners.

**Added New Staff Members** - With the help of the EANS federal grant, we have added two staff members that will be working to support students and staff throughout the building. Staff members will be going into classrooms and working in small groups to help the diverse learning needs of all students.

Process for Analyzing Goals - Every month of the school year, we have staff development time dedicated to the analysis of student data and how this will support the overall goals of our students and staff. We have begun the year analyzing KAP Assessments from the Spring 2021. The results were excellent but in order to remain a school of excellence we must continue to analyze what makes us great and continue to keep those high expectations.

**Long-Term Strategic Plan** - With the help of our School Advisory Council, our plan will ask for input from many of the school's stakeholders. As part of this plan, we will continue to focus on the learning of all students with different modalities.
