"We are so excited to partner with the Lawrence Humane Society and help provide them with their most-needed donations! We have a donation bin located in each homeroom where you can drop off items. The items listed are what is needed most at the moment but other items the shelter utilizes on a regular basis include: old & clean towels, bedding (no fitted sheets, please), small bath mats for cat kennels, cat scratchers, gently used leashes and collars, peanut butter (any brand), puppy potty pads. If you would like to order from their Amazon wishlist, it can be delivered directly to the shelter.


ST. JOHN BENEFIT AUCTION
