The items listed are what is needed most at the moment but other items the shelter utilizes on a regular basis include: old & clean towels, bedding (no fitted sheets, please), small bath mats for cat kennels, cat scratchers, gently used leashes and collars, peanut butter (any brand), puppy potty pads. If you would like to order from their Amazon wishlist, it can be delivered directly to the shelter.

Prayers & Thank Yous


 Continued prayers for the citizens of Ukraine that have been forced to flee from their homes, for those unable to leave and must find shelter, and for those that are fighting for their country.


ST. JOHN BENEFIT AUCTION


