## Weather related information for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd

If St. John school and or the public schools are cancelled due to weather related issues, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd sessions will not meet. If possible, weather related cancellations will be announced on the parish website at <a href="http://www.sjevangelist.com">www.sjevangelist.com</a>.

- Catechesis of the Good Shepherd sessions will be cancelled, if a tornado watch is issued one hour or less before the beginning of the session.
- In the event of a tornado warning during a Catechesis of the Good Shepherd session, the catechists will take the children to the church basement. To get everyone to safety as quickly as possible, the group will enter the church basement by way of the double doors on the north side of the church.
- If there is immediate danger that doesn't allow time to move the children to the church basement, the catechists and children will shelter in the bathroom of the Atrium house.
- In all cases, if weather conditions are undesirable, parents should use their own discretion, when it comes to taking their child/children to a Catechesis of the Good Shepherd session.
